This one frame exhibit presents subject items in mint condition with the exception of a FDC which is signed by the artist.

Shown is a MEDIA release where the stamps are smaller than on the Working Proof. Followed by this is a very rare dummy booklet used as working proof. Thereafter four booklets with self-adhesive stamps of different printing / issue dates.

Two different booklets are shown, one where the stamps are vertical and the other horizontal with security perforation. These booklets were issued for the centenary celebration of the Kruger National Park and for Aids Prevention.

On the last six pages five antelopes on postcards are presented each with three different printings. One of these pages illustrates what can happen during the printing process.

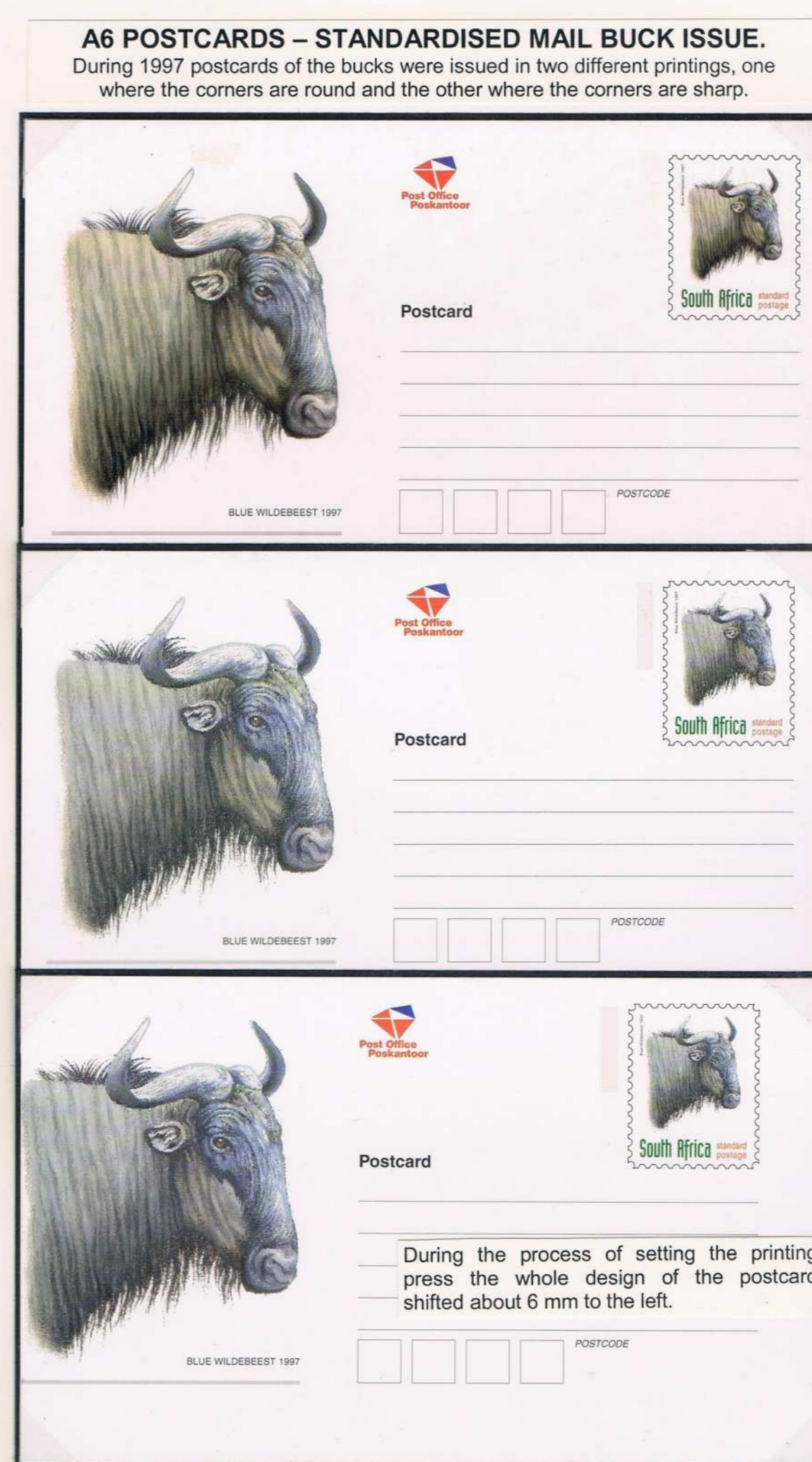

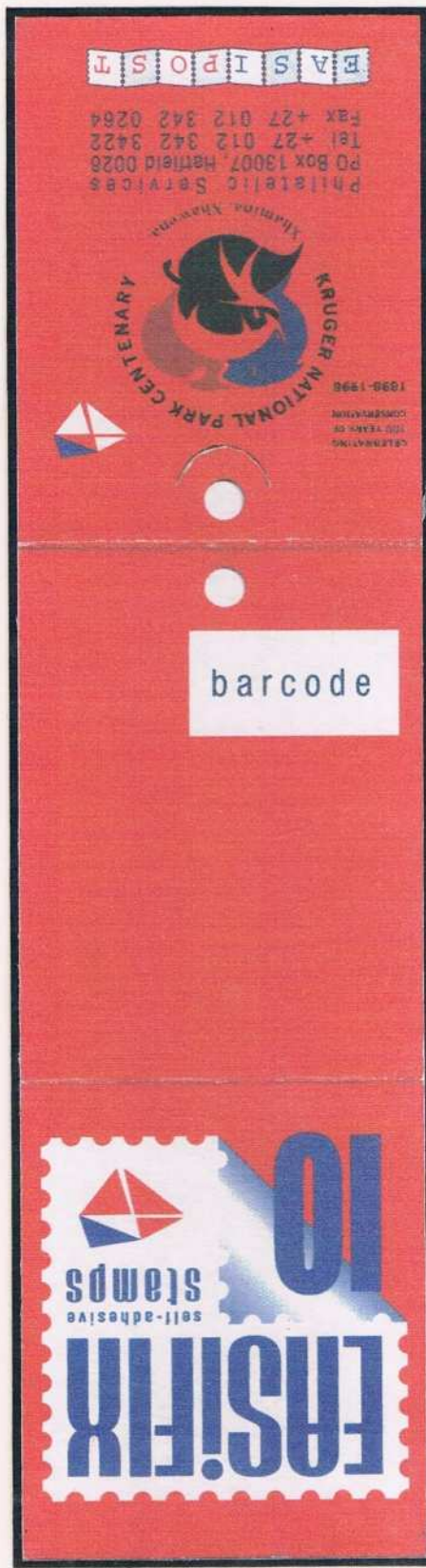

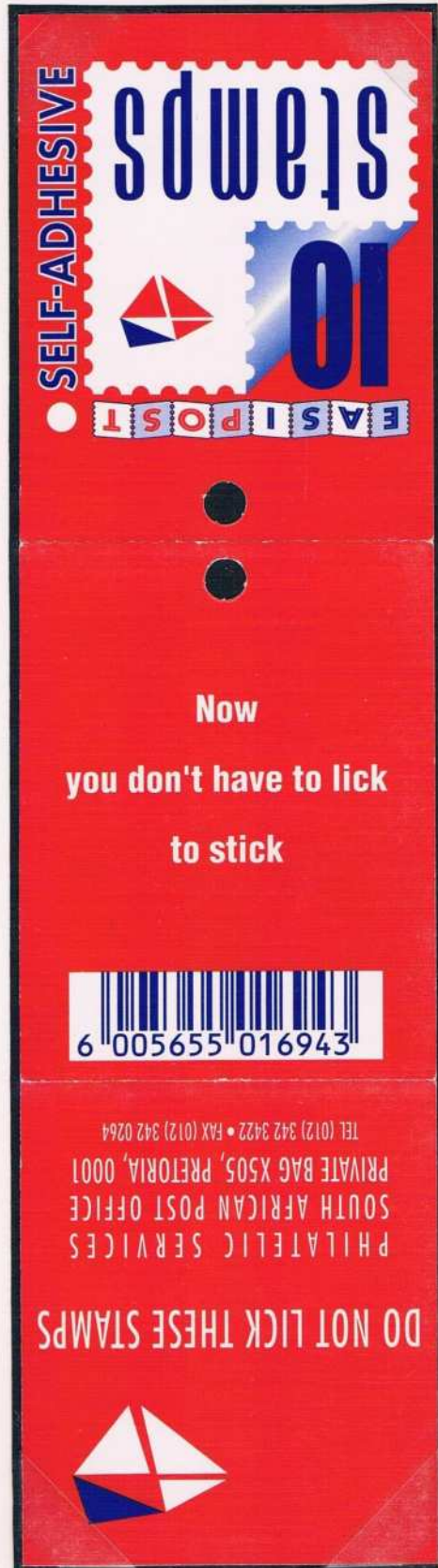

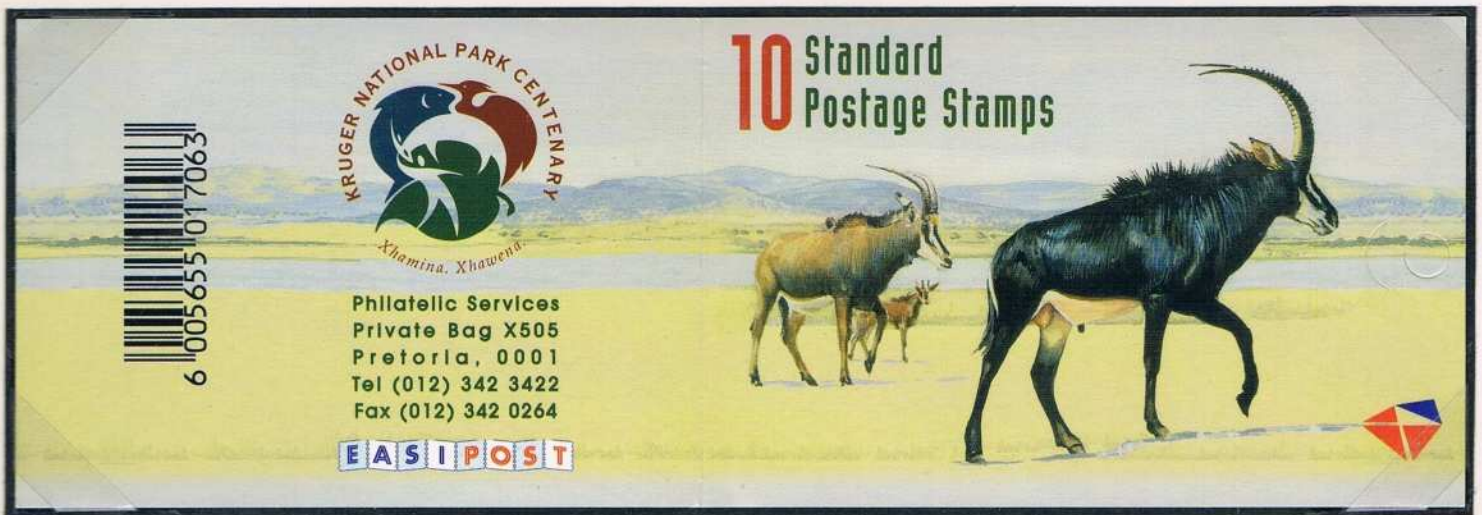
