

## RECIPIENTS OF J HARVEY PIRIE AWARD

**Congress 1965, Paarl decided with acclamation to recognise the long and distinguished service to PFSA by Dr JH Harvey Pirie by establishing an award called the J H Harvey Pirie Memorial Award.**

Award initially was R400 plus certificate; changed 2011 to R1k; changed 2012 to R2k.
