



NOVSKA - POST TRAFFIC

Novska, small town in west Slavonija with 6000 inhabitants is important railway cross-roads well known for 3 million years old excavated snail "ogre". This area was populated at the roman time, but the first written document about the name of Novska was in documents of episcopacy in Zagreb from 1334.

Post traffic in Novska was established at the time of military frontier. Novska was in that time captaincy and it was belonging to regiment of Nova Gradiška. The exact date of opening post-office wasn't noted for, but Luka Ilić Oriovčanin was noted: "With regulation of border-line regiment 1750, 38 post-office more was build". Although Ilić doesn't mention the names of places of post-offices, by tradition in Novska it was the building of the old pharmacy. The merchant Marko Suzanić from Rijeka 21st of January 1784 was submitted suggestion of direction mail from Petrinja to Kostajnica, and to Novska, forward to Petrorovaradin. (PTT archive number 17. from 1971/72). According to Cividini "Post handling stamps of Croatia 1755-1918 post-office was opened 1787.

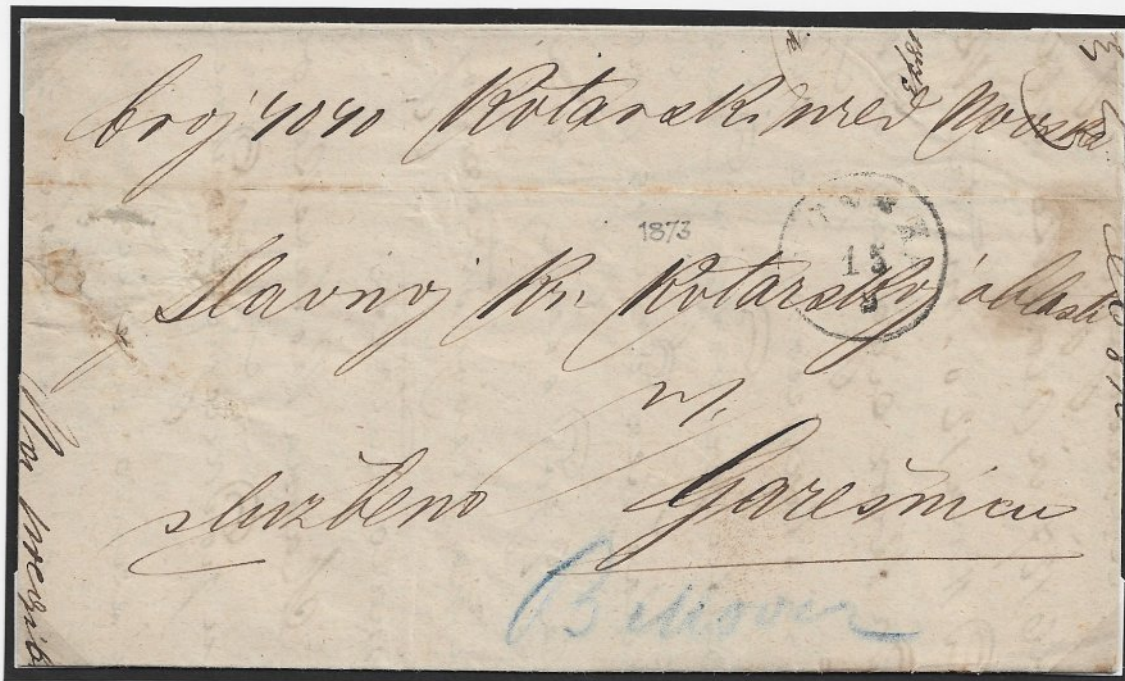
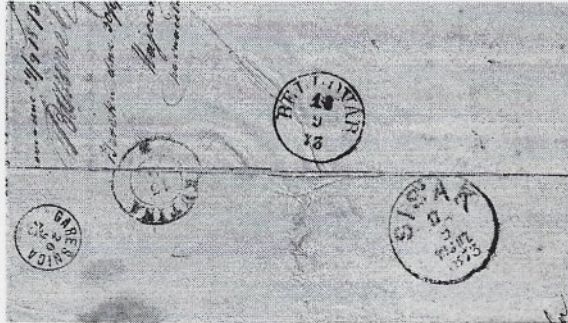

The circular stamp of post-office Novska with the name of post-office, and the mark of date and month.



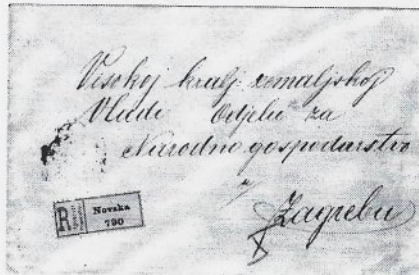
Letter has sent from Novska 15th Semptember 1873 to Garešnica across Kutina, Sisak and Kjelovar.



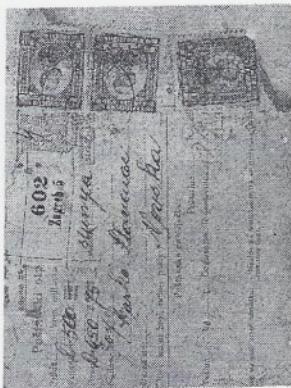
Unperforated Hungarian stamp in value of 2 "Krajcar" stamped by post-office Novska. Stamp was edited 1874.

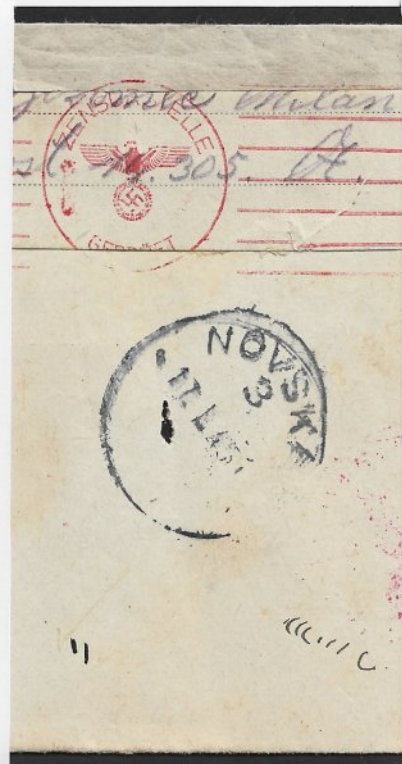


The letter was sent from Donji Milanovaca to Novska 7th Juni 1940. It was used a stamp of Yugoslavia with shape of King Petar from 1939.

The letter was sent from Novska to Zagreb 23rd December 1942. It was used a official stamp of Independent of Croatia from 1942.



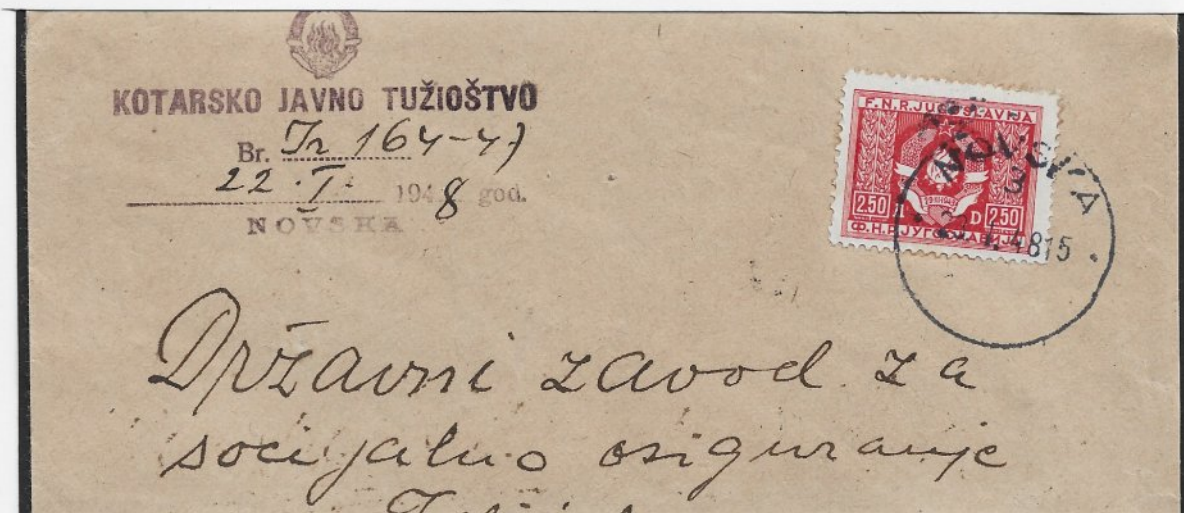
The was letter on November, 27th from the conentration camp in Germany in the Stara Subotska . The letter was passed censorship and arrived at the destinatio January 17th 1945.

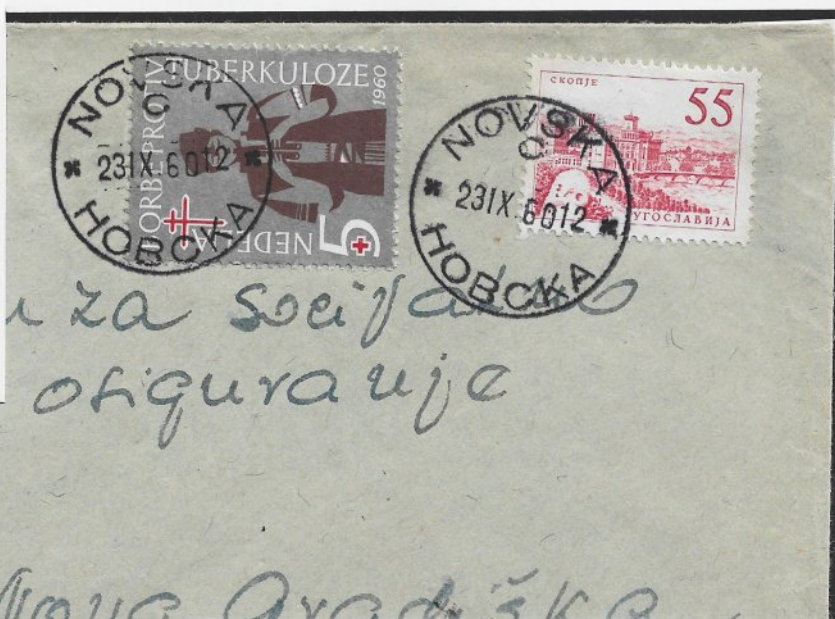

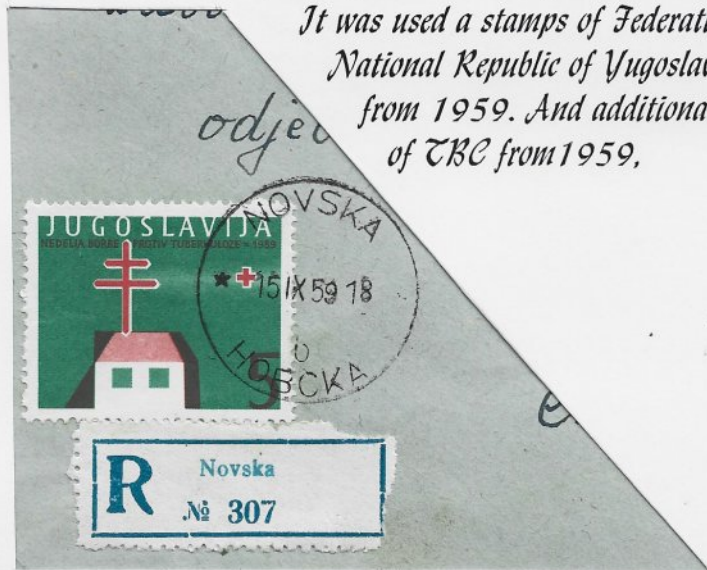

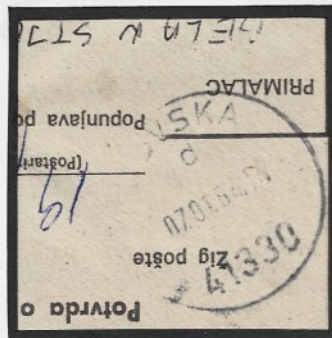


The letter was sent from Novska to Novska 1st April 1983. It was used a stamp of Federative National Republic of Yugoslavia with stamp of Tito from 1974.

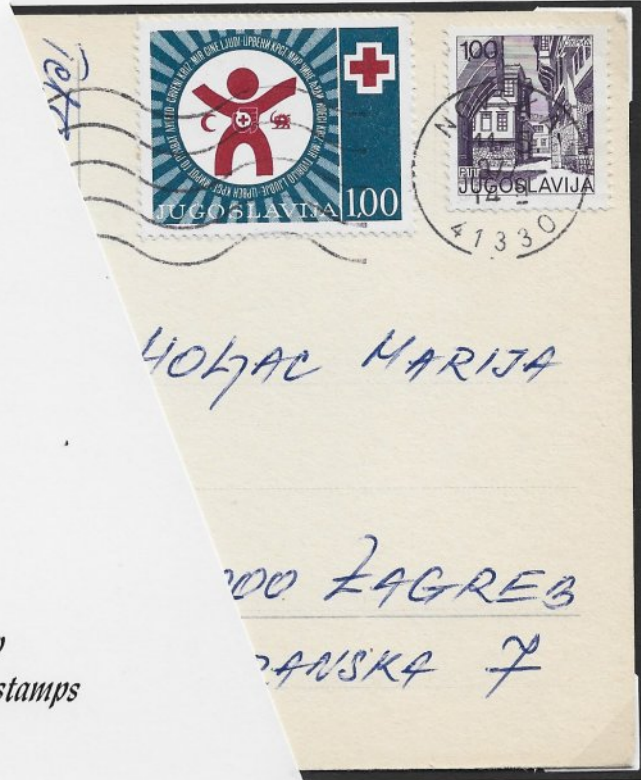

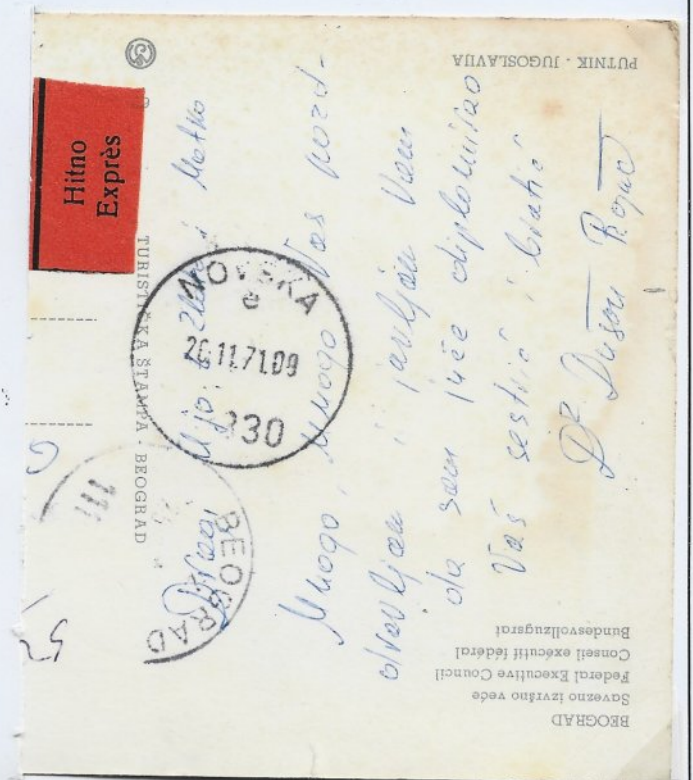
